## APPLICATION-PROCESS

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### To apply for the ESLSCA Paris students mobility, following documents must be sent :

- Application Form
  - Cover Letter (in English)
  - Curriculum Vitae (in English)
  - Official academic transcripts in English or French signed and stamped by the home institution
  - A copy of a valid passport
  - One official photo.
  - English Proficiency Certificate (level B2)
  - European health card (for EU Students)
  - Proof of health insurance (for non-EU students)
  - Student visa (for non-European students)
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## APPLICATION DEADLINES

### FALL 2024

Application files must be sent by May 31st, 2024.

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### SPRING 2025

Application files must be sent by October 31st 2024.

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## STUDY OPPORTUNITIES

ESLSCA Business School Paris offers more than 20 programs across various fields in French. International students can choose from the following programs:

## PRACTICAL INFORMATION

### ACCOMODATION

A student housing platform is proposed to all our students. It offers an extensive number of offers in Paris or in the surrounding areas.

Average cost for housing / month: between 700€ and 1000€

A housing state grant (APL) is open to international students: about 180€/month

As none of the options are managed by ESLSCA, housing cannot be guaranteed. Students can find accommodation by themselves.

### INSURANCES

#### HEALTH

All ESLSCA students must hold a health insurance for the entire duration of the study period.

Once the students arrive in France, they must register on the French Health Care platform: <https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/>

Non-European students are required to submit a valid insurance certificate, translated into English, before their arrival in France.

European students must provide a valid European health card.

#### CIVIL LIABILITY INSURANCE

It is mandatory for all students to have a civil liability insurance upon their arrival in France.
